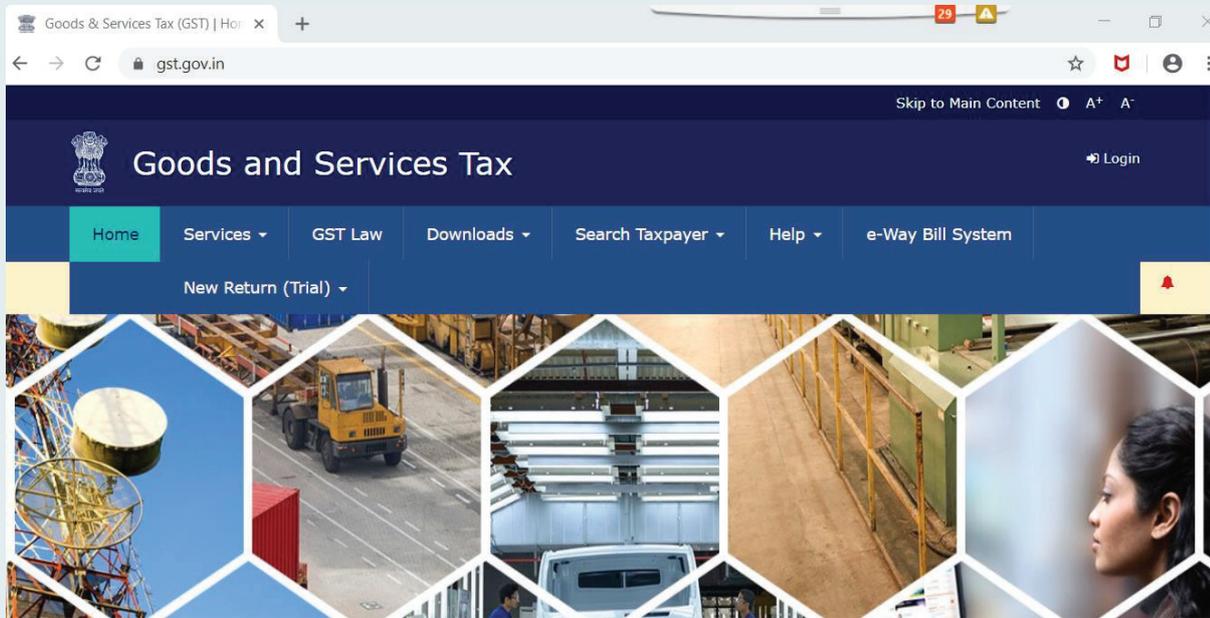
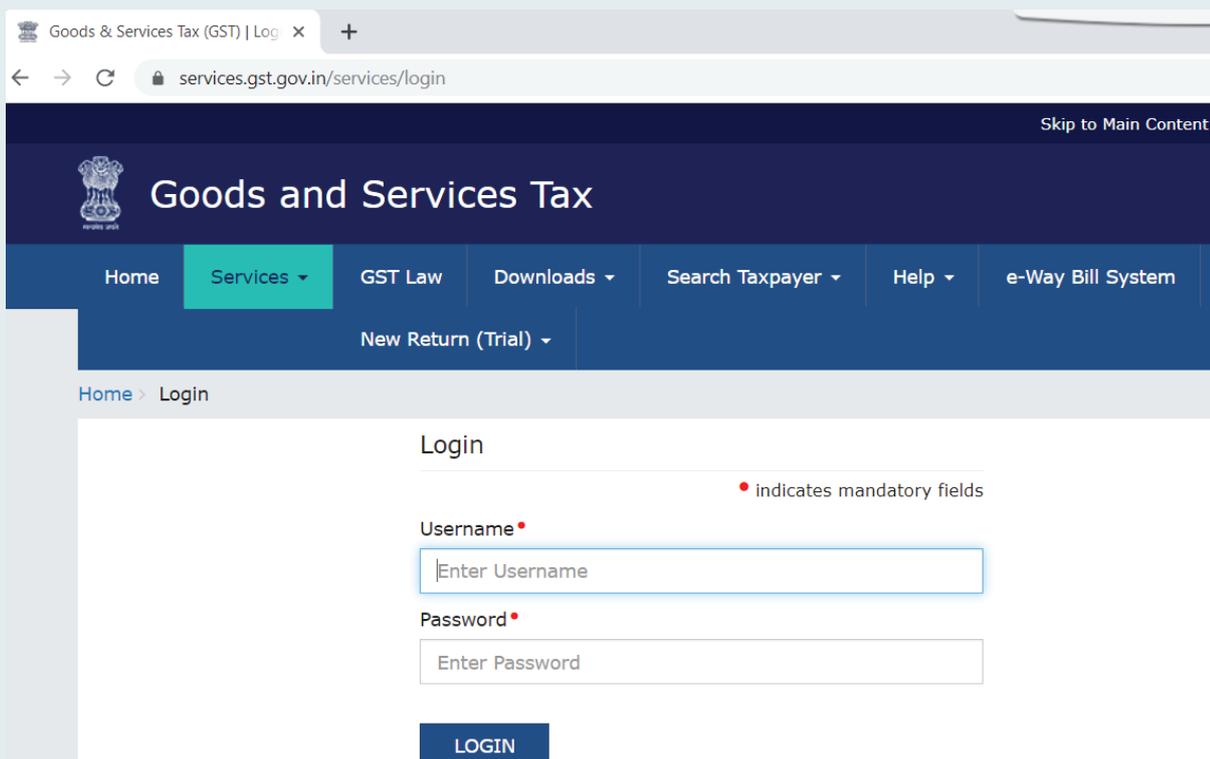




1. Select the GST Payments and you will be redirected to www.gst.gov.in.
