


Deutsche Signer Installation for Mac

1. System Requirement

- JAVA required - JDK 8 need to be installed in the system
- To check the java version installed in the System, open terminal and type command `java -version`





2. Below are steps for installation of signer file in mac -


- Download the signer tool (for Mac) from below location-
https://login.deutschebank.co.in/downloads/DeutscheSigner_Mac.dmg
- Double click on the dmg file




- Double Click on DeutscheSigner.pkg file




- Enter System Username and Password and click on Install Software




- Enter System Username and Password and click on Update Settings



- Post completion of installation below confirmation screen is displayed.




- After installation, the service will get started automatically with the popup as DeutscheSigner service started successfully. Click on ok in popup window




- Once the DeutscheSigner is started it will get minimized in the address bar (near to date and time) as shown in below screenshot



- Post Service Start Open DeutscheSigner verify in the pop-up the message displaying service started successfully as shown below



- Post Installation DeutscheSigner can be accessed anytime from the launchpad by clicking on DeutscheSigner Utility




3. Below are steps for uninstallation of DeutscheSigner file in mac -


- Click on Go option from toolbar and select Go to Folder



- Enter following path in Go to Folder **/Library/eMudhra/DeutscheSigner** and click on Go



- Open UninstallSigner file from the DeutscheSigner Folder



- Enter System password in terminal and press return/enter, DeutscheSigner will get uninstalled from your system
